Gary & Dana McBurney are working with OSU Extension Service and the City of Owasso to address the island that has developed in the lake behind the golf course.

Dean Danklefsen has submitted an email to the city requesting they investigate and address the condition of the streets in Southern Links. The email was answered. The streets were inspected and they agree a plan needs to be developed to address the

deteriorating condition of the streets in all areas of our subdivision. Dean is going to follow up within about 2 months to see where they are with development of a plan to repair our streets. The tax vote of January 13th will probably go a long way toward determining when our streets will be repaired.
